## WBS-WFD STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP STRENGTHENS WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION AND LEADERSHIP IN MALAYSIA'S DEMOCRATIC LANDSCAPE

SHAH ALAM, 23 June 2025 – *Wanita Berdaya Selangor* (WBS) marked a historic milestone today by signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Westminster Foundation for Democracy (WFD), representing a strategic step forward in strengthening women's participation and leadership in Malaysia's democratic landscape. The signing ceremony took place at the MTES Meeting Room, SSAAS Building, Shah Alam.

The ceremony also marked the symbolic beginning of a bilateral collaboration to support the implementation of the Gender Observatory Programme under the Women Political Leadership Programme (Phase II), which will run from May to August 2025.
