SELANGOR INTERNATIONAL CARE SUMMIT CATALYSES VISION FOR ASIA-PACIFIC'S PREMIER CARE HUB

1. The Selangor State Government, through the Standing Committee on Care Economy, held the inaugural three-day Selangor International Care Summit 2025 to transform the care ecosystem in Selangor — marking a significant step towards realising the vision of making Selangor the Asia-Pacific Care Hub.
2. The Summit featured four key components — the Care Townhall, Care Forum, Care Business Matching, and Care Expo. It drew international attention to Selangor's care economy, with exhibitors from Finland and Japan, business partners from South Korea, and speakers from Indonesia, Australia, and India — underscoring the State's growing reputation as a regional hub for care innovation.
3. Aiming to attract 3,000 participants over three days, the Summit exceeded expectations on its first day alone, welcoming 1,100 participants across various sessions. The Care Townhall drew nearly 500 attendees, far surpassing the original target of 300 participants, reflecting strong public engagement with Selangor's care agenda.
4. Meanwhile, the Care Expo showcased 54 exhibitors presenting a diverse range of innovative care products, services, and technologies — highlighting the expanding business potential of the care economy.
5. Crucially, the Care Business Matching segment showcased how the Summit is driving the growth of the care business ecosystem — connecting 167 registered companies through AI-powered matching sessions.
6. Several Memoranda of Understanding (MoU) were signed between government agencies and local businesses with international partners, among them a collaboration between Yayasan Warisan Anak Selangor (YAWAS) and UNIUNI from South Korea to introduce and localise assistive device technology and innovation in Malaysia.
7. Many prospective collaborators were first introduced to Selangor's care economy vision during this Summit, and further partnerships and MoUs are expected to be formalised in the coming months as a direct outcome of the connections and confidence built through this platform.
8. The Care Summit was powered by Wanita Berdaya Selangor, Hayat Technologies, and KiddoCare — a shining example of effective public-private collaboration in advancing the care economy agenda. The Summit also received generous funding support from the Ministry of Health Malaysia, Selgate Corporation, Greentact Solutions Sdn. Bhd., and Yayasan Hasanah.

**SELANGOR INTERNATIONAL CARE SUMMIT MEMACU VISI HUB PENJAGAAN
TERUNGGLUL ASIA-PASIFIK**

1. Kerajaan Negeri Selangor melalui Jawatankuasa Tetap Ekonomi Penjagaan telah mengadakan Selangor International Care Summit 2025 selama tiga hari buat kali pertama — menandakan sebuah langkah penting terhadap merealisasikan visi menjadikan Selangor Hub Penjagaan bagi Rantau Asia-Pasifik.
2. Sidang Kemuncak ini mempunyai empat komponen utama iaitu Care Townhall, Care Forum, Care Business Matching, dan Care Expo. Sidang Kemuncak ini telah menarik perhatian dunia terhadap ekonomi penjagaan di negeri Selangor dengan pempamer dari Finland dan Jepun, rakan kongsi perniagaan dari Korea Selatan, dan penyampai-penyampai dari Indonesia, Australia, and India — menandakan peningkatan reputasi negeri ini sebagai hub penjagaan rantau ini.
3. Dengan sasaran seramai 3,000 peserta sepanjang tempoh tiga hari, Sidang Kemuncak ini telah berjaya mengatasi sasaran dengan kehadiran 1,100 peserta pada hari pertamanya. Care Townhall pula dihadiri oleh hampir 500 peserta, mengatasi sasaran awal iaitu seramai 300 peserta, menandakan sokongan yang memberansangkan terhadap agenda penjagaan Selangor.
4. Manakala bagi Care Expo pula, 54 pempamer telah mempamerkan pelbagai produk, kemahiran, dan teknologi penjagaan yang inovatif — menonjolkan potensi perniagaan dalam ekonomi penjagaan yang semakin berkembang.
5. Selain itu, segmen Care Business Matching membuktikan Sidang Kemuncak ini memacu perkembangan ekosistem perniagaan penjagaan — menghubungkan 167 syarikat-syarikat yang telah berdaftar dengan bantuan kecerdasan buatan.
6. Beberapa Memorandum Persetujuan (MoU) telah ditandatangani antara agensi kerajaan mahupun perniagaan tempatan dengan syarikat-syarikat luar negara, salah satunya ialah antara Yayasan Warisan Anak Selangor (YAWAS) dan syarikat UNIUNI daripada Korea Selatan untuk memperkenalkan teknologi bantu di Malaysia.
7. Banyak rakan kerjasama berpotensi yang diperkenalkan dengan visi ekonomi penjagaan Selangor melalui sidang kemuncak ini, serta kerjasama akan diusahakan dalam beberapa bulan akan datang.
8. Sidang Kemuncak Penjagaan ini digerakkan dengan kerjasama Wanita Berdaya Selangor, Hayat Technologies, dan KiddoCare — bukti keberkesanan kerjasama awam-swasta dalam memajukan agenda penjagaan. Sidang ini juga menerima sokongan dalam bentuk dana daripada Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia, Selgate Corporation, Greentact Solutions Sdn Bhd, dan Yayasan Hasanah.
